

The Pentecostal Theological Seminary is committed to the provision of reasonable accommodations for students with disabilities to ensure equal educational and programmatic access for eligible students with documented disabilities. We are committed to providing students with the opportunity to reach their full potential by developing academic accommodations and support services along with promoting independence and self-advocacy for all students. To be eligible for disability-related services, students must have a documented or visible impairment as defined by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act (1973), the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA, 1990) and the ADA Amendments Act (ADA-AA, 2008 and the amended ADA of 2011).

The ADA regulations broadly define disability impairments to include a wide variety of disorders or conditions including ADD/ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorders, Medical/Health Conditions, Sensory Impairments, Learning Disabilities, Mobility/Physical Disabilities, and Psychological Disabilities.
